**Project Idea:** The Department of Parks & Recreation, in partnership with the Dartmouth Public Libraries and the Dartmouth School Department seeks to develop a community park. The project location is the open, green space linking Southworth Library and Cushman School.

**Design:** Phase I is designed to include the building of a community-access loop, reading areas and walking paths and Phase II is designed to include 3 age-appropriate play equipment areas, benches, picnic tables, lighting and landscaping.

**Goals:** Safer access for community residents to this park, the creation of outdoor reading and congregating spaces, increased parking and access to ball fields and multi-generational walking spaces that are handicapped accessible for all.

**Public Support:** Community Residents and local businesses may gift specific aspects of the project in memory or honor of a loved one:

- Recycled plastic benches at \$1000 each
- Wheelchair accessible picnic tables at \$1500 each
- Trees and shrubbery at \$200 each
