ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

This is a basic 1-story Cape Cod dwelling and farmstead complex. The house is 5-bays wide by 2-bays deep with a small but tall centered brick chimney, wood shingle siding and a stone foundation. The front entrance is centered and appears to be a solid panel door behind an aluminum storm door. The door and window trim is simple narrow flat boards. Windows are wood 2/2 with aluminum storms. There are a pair of windows in each gable endwall. A small rear ell off the left back corner appears to have been added to serve as a mudroom sheltering the rear entrance. On the left side a modern picture window has been installed, consisting of a large fixed sash flanked by narrow 1/1 windows.

There are five farm buildings including a large front gable cow barn, set near the road with a grain silo, an attached 1-story creamery, three 1-story gable roof sheds, and a concrete block shed. All except the concrete shed are wood shingled and appear to date from the mid-to-late 19th century.

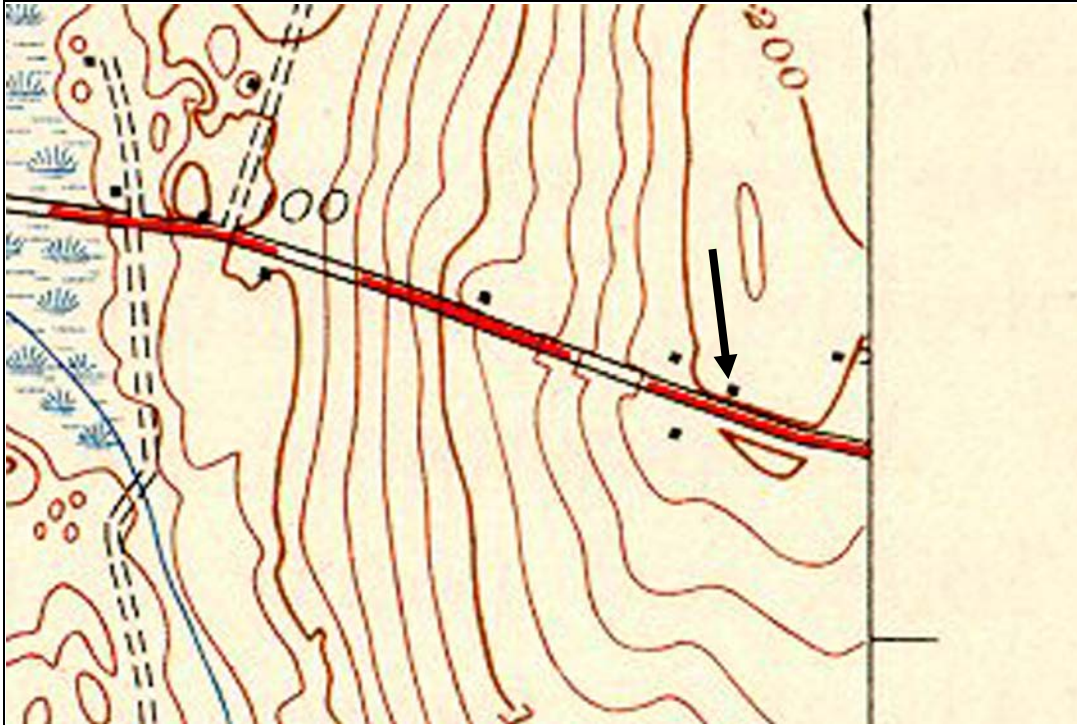

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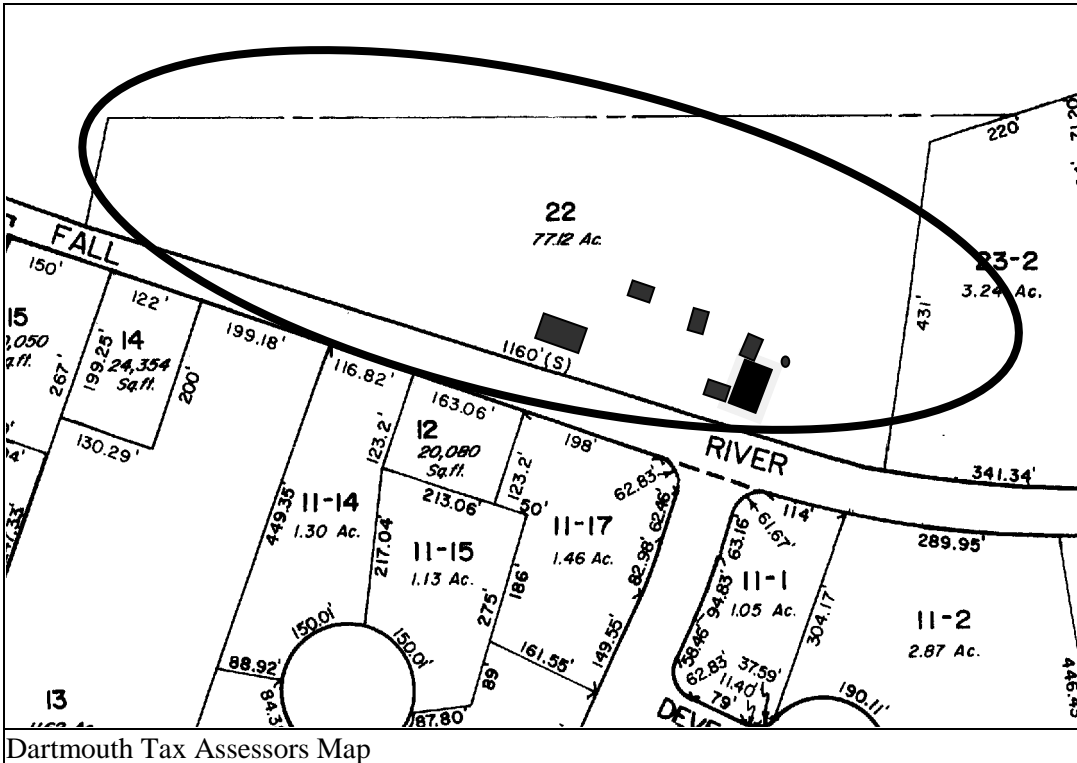
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LOCATION MAPPING

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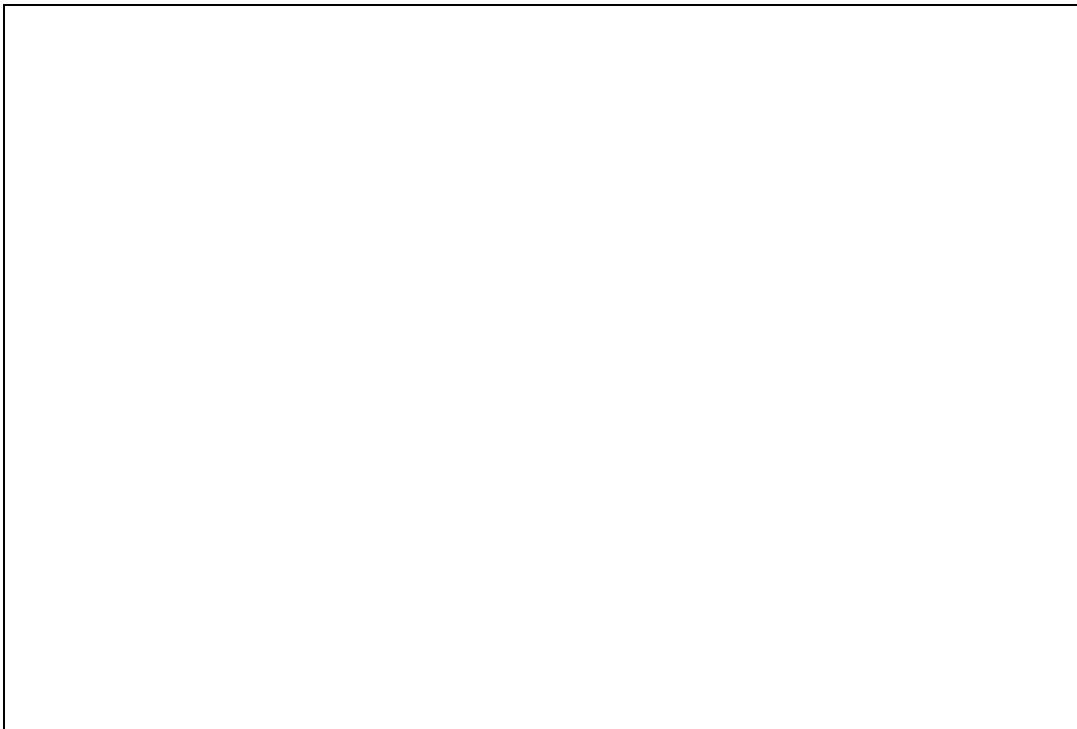
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
