ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

This dwelling is an imposing Federal house, simple, yet impressive. It is 2 ½ stories in height, with two end chimneys. The moderately pitched roof slopes down to a cornice, under which is a course of dentils. The front façade is symmetric with regard to window and entrance placement. Doorway, in the center, is framed by pilasters, semi-circular fanlight, and broken pediment. Windows, two on either side of door on first floor, and five at second story level, are capped with splayed lintels. Foundation is of granite. [Note: Preceding description transcribed from 1983 survey form]

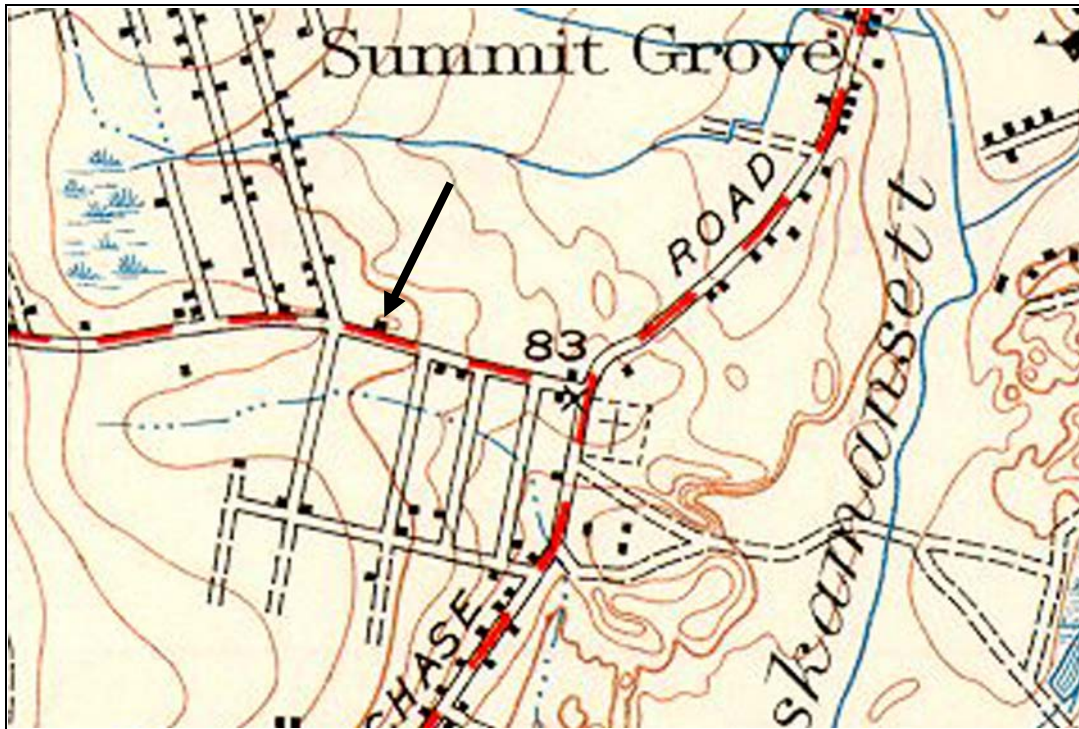

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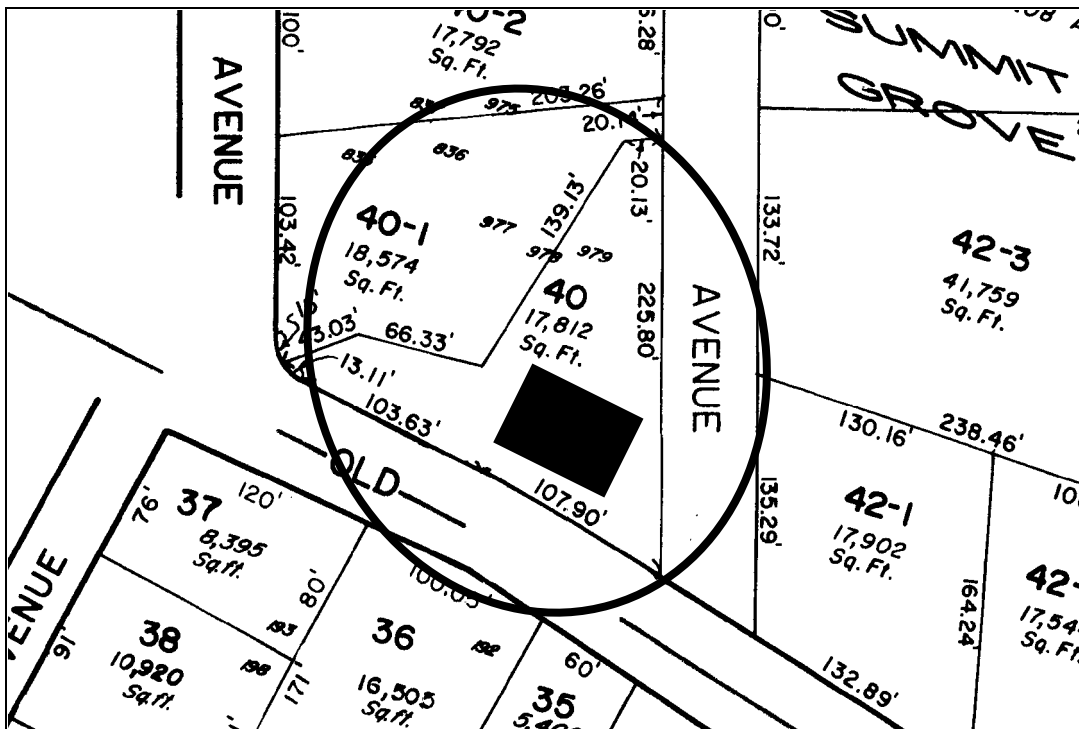
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LOCATION MAPPING
