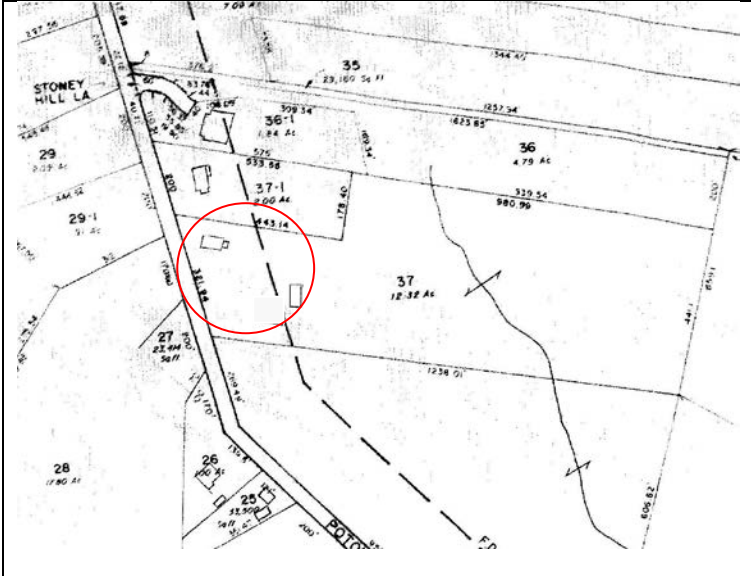

ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

Describe architectural features. Evaluate the characteristics of this building in terms of other buildings within the community.

The dwelling at 751 Potomska Road is a one story Bungalow that is set back from the street approximately forty feet. Dense plantings between the house and the road obscure views of the dwelling. The rectangular plan residence rests on a stone foundation. The front gable roof is sheathed in asphalt shingles. The walls are clad in vinyl siding. To the rear of the dwelling obscured from the drive or road is a late 20th century barn.

HISTORICAL NARRATIVE

Discuss the history of the building. Explain its associations with local (or state) history. Include uses of the building, and the role(s) the owners/occupants played within the community.

Although the Assessor's Records assign an 1880 construction date, given the Bungalow form of the dwelling and the lack of a dwelling in this area c1895, the dwelling was likely built in the early 20th century. Additional Deed research would be necessary to determine early 20th century owners. Clarence & Anne Johnson (1950s); Frederick Tripp, a salesman & his wife Louise (1953-1961); Richard Lawrence, a machinist, and his wife Ellma, a receptionist (1961-1967); Harry Miller (1967-1971); Olive B Miller (1971-1975); Harry & Carol Ann Miller (1975-1977); Roland Massey Jr. (1977-1979); John & Patricia Carreiro (1979-1997); Blisscapes Tree Farm and Nursery, William Gil 1994-present
