## ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

This structure is a 1-story Colonial Cape Cod house with a small brick central chimney and a stone foundation. The centered entrance is flanked by paired windows that likely replace what were single windows. The windows are modern wood 6/6 divided light replacement windows. An enclosed entrance porch with an asymmetrical front gable roof rests on a cement block foundation and appears to be a mid-20<sup>th</sup> c. alteration. A shed roof dormer extends across the rear roof. A modern short casement window has been installed on the left side near the back, presumably over a kitchen sink. Trim consists of flat casings, narrow corner boards and wide fascia boards up the rake.

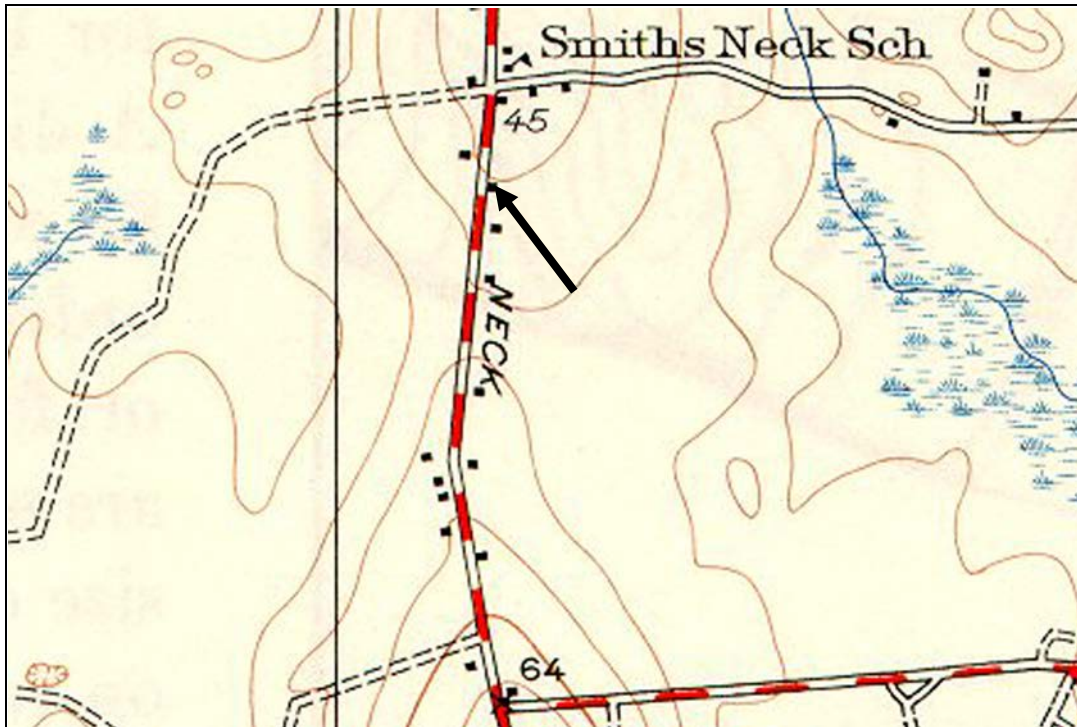

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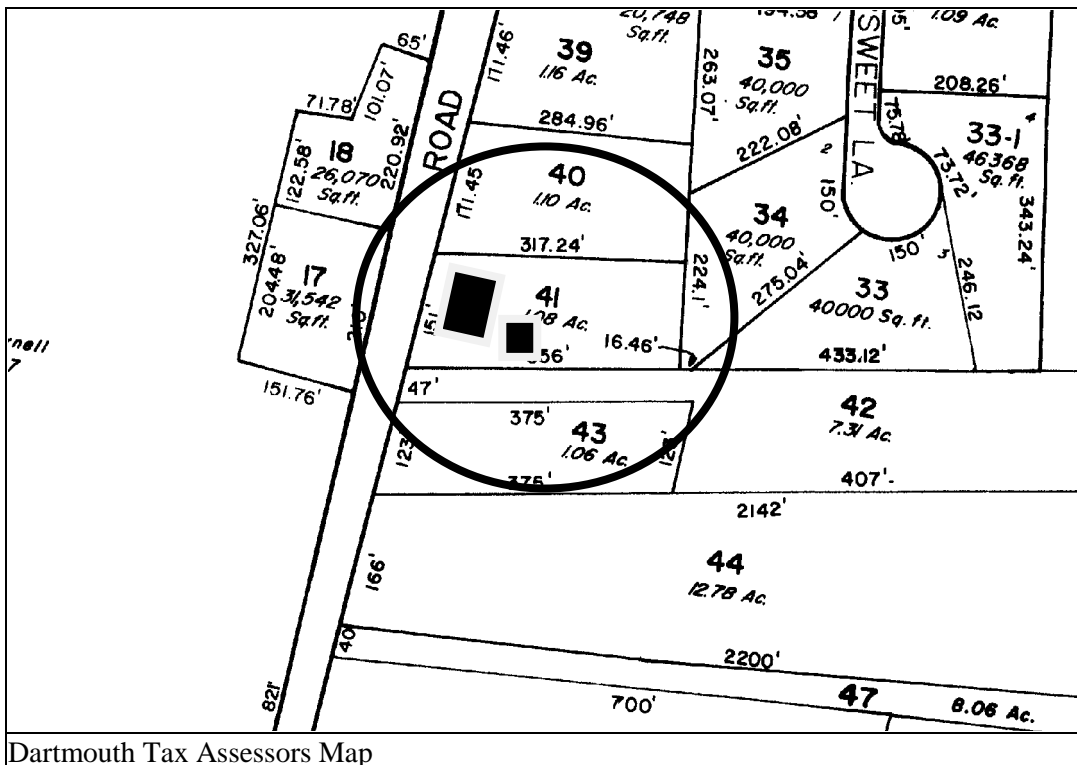
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## LOCATION MAPPING
