## ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

This four bay 2 ½ story Georgian structure is typical of this type of dwelling in the Dartmouth area. The windows are 12/8 and there are simple pilasters at the corner. The roof is surmounted by a large brick chimneystack. Over the door is a simple pediment which is triangular. The entire building is sheathed in wood shingles. [Note: Preceding description transcribed from 1983 survey form]

This house has been extensively altered since 1983. Windows and doors have been replaced, removed, and added. A large 2 story wing has also been added. See photos.

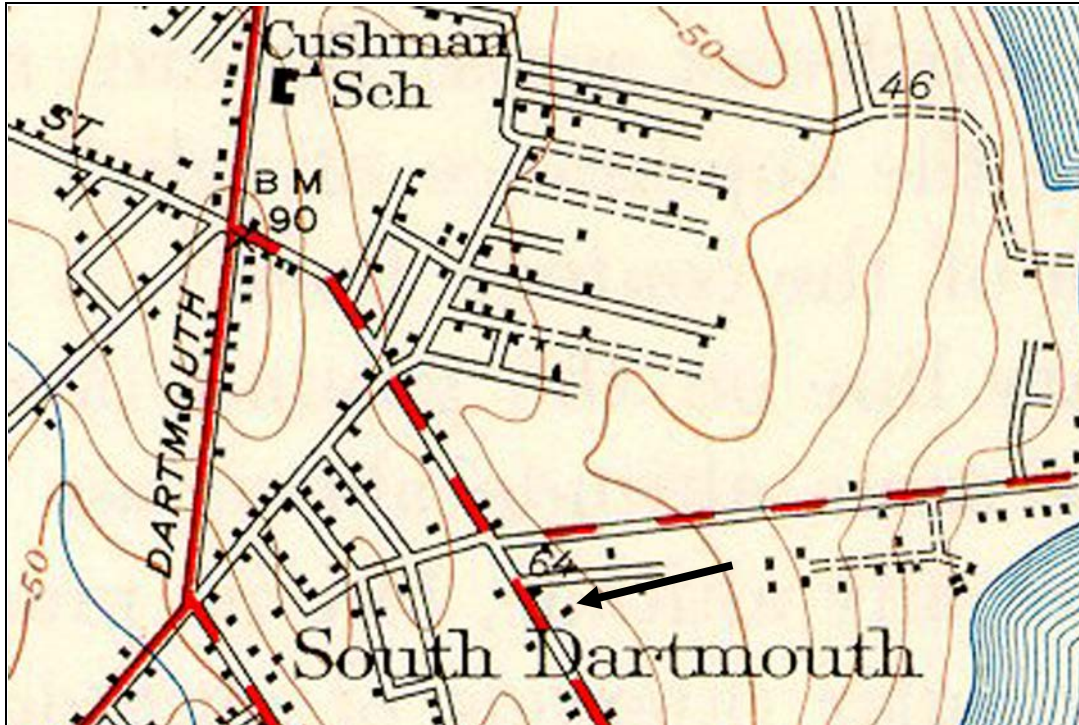

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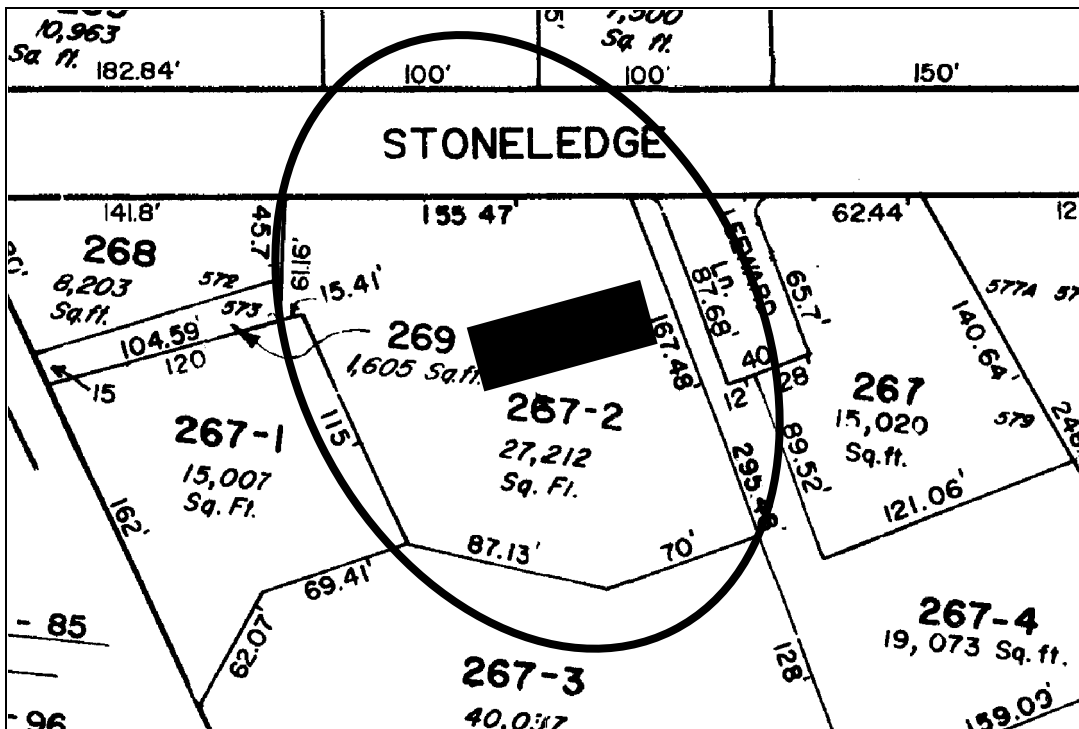
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**LOCATION MAPPING**
