ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

This Federal structure is typical of those of that period in the town of Dartmouth. The front façade is symmetrical in terms of window and doorway placement. The doorway is framed by pilasters, transom light, and closed pediment. The windows are topped by splayed lintels. Roof is of a moderate pitch and the cornice at the front façade is slightly extended. Chimney placement is two off center. Foundation is uncharacteristically brick, whereas the vast majority of Federal structures, as well as other structures have granite foundations. 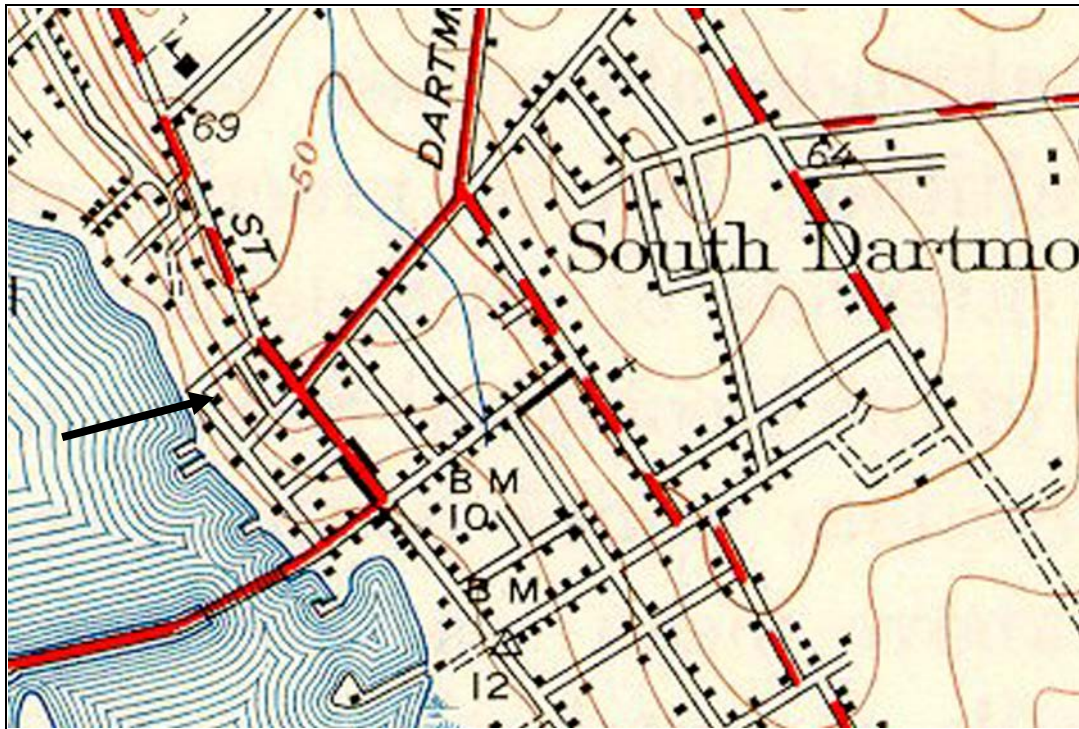

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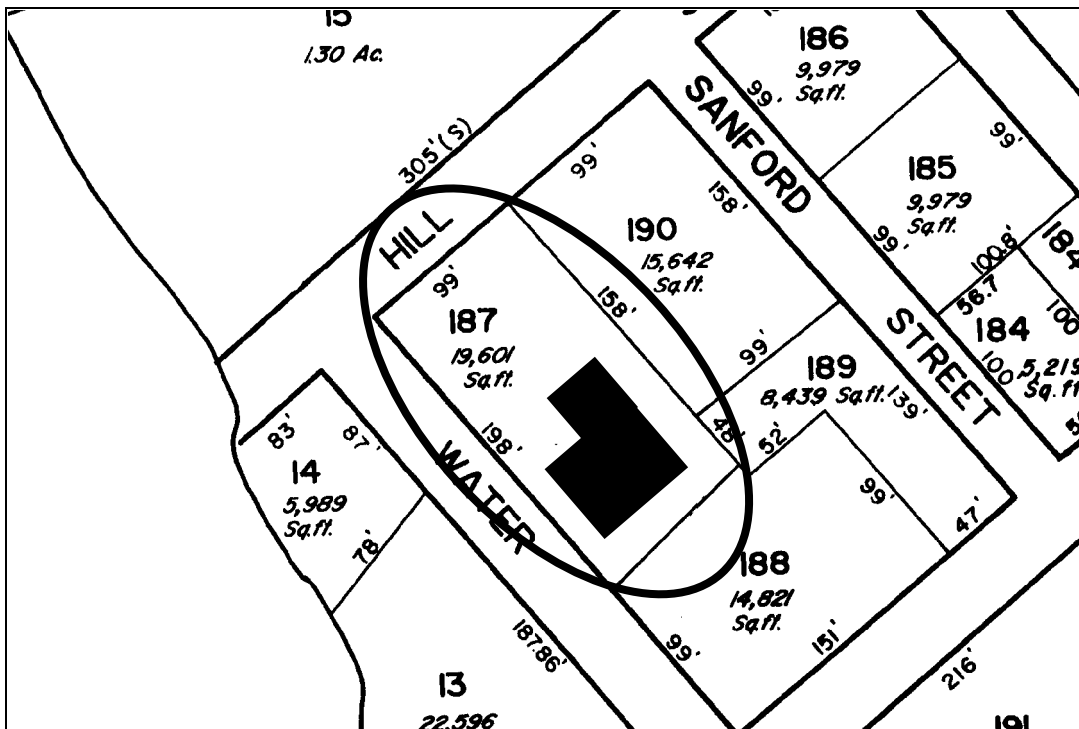
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LOCATION MAPPING
