Such ownership, easement interest or permission is a prerequisite to the lawful use of any such permit or determination of exemption under this Article. By accepting a permit or determination of exemption, the applicant concurrently accepts these restrictions and agrees to indemnify the Town and its boards, commissions, committees, officers, employees, officials, agents and attorney against any claims that are response to any removal activities that are conducted pursuant to said permit or determination of exemption.
