ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

This is a basic 1-1/2 story Cape Cod dwelling, 5-bays wide by 2-bays deep. It has a center brick chimney and a stone foundation. The walls and roof are wood shingled. The centered entrance is framed with raised pilasters and a row of 6 narrow transom lights across the top. A solid wood vertical plank storm door with reproduction iron strap hinges is mounted over the main entry door. Windows are all 12/12 sash, protected by aluminum storms and capped by splayed lintels. The windows on the front façade butt the front façade's frieze board. A rear entrance is identical to the front but not centered. There is a wide shed dormer on the rear roof with a row of 8 windows capped by a single long splayed lintel.

This house was reportedly moved back on the lot from its original location close to the road. It was entirely "restored" inside and out. All of the exterior materials are new. The rear dormer was obviously added or the fenestration modified; the chimney also new, probably larger than the original.

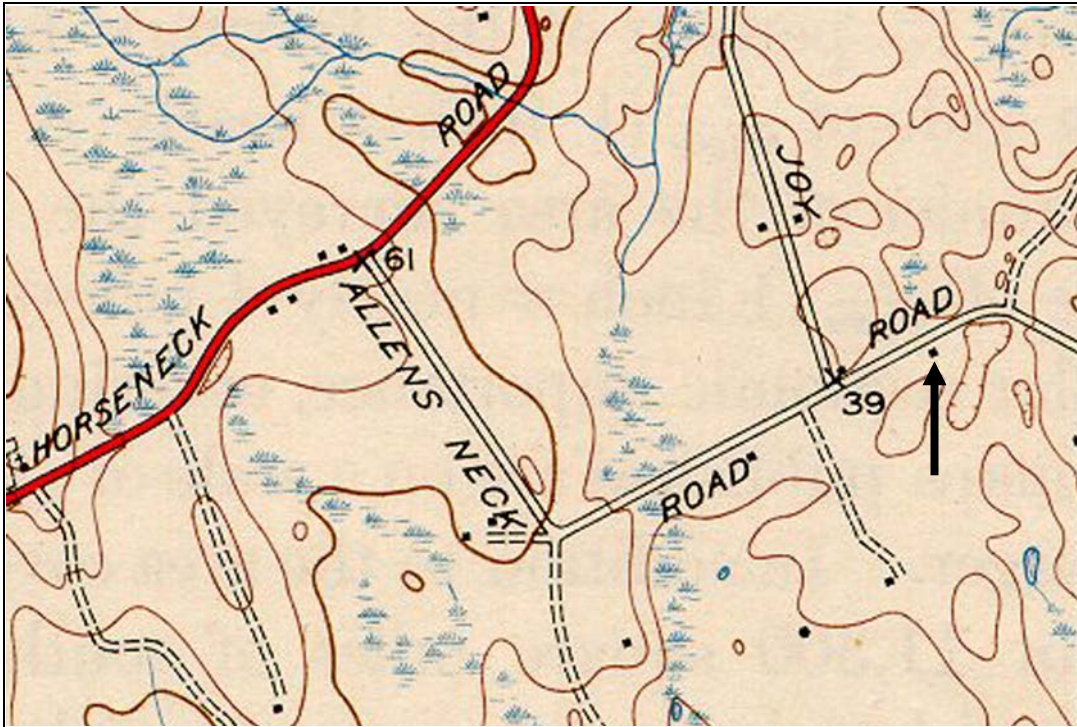

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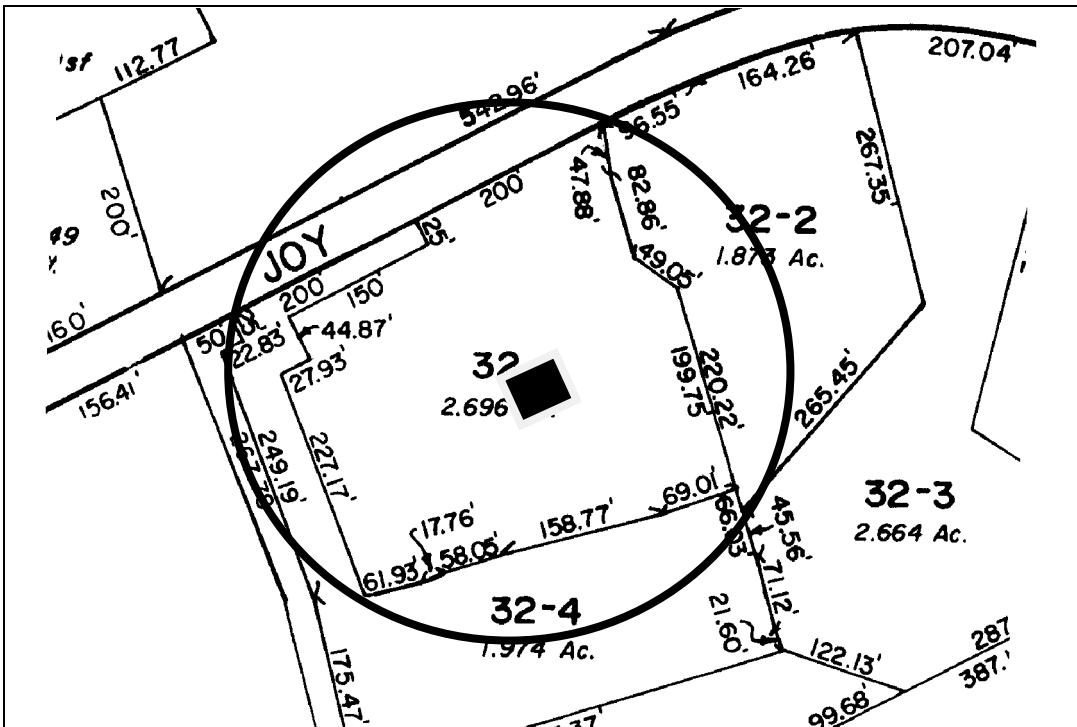
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LOCATION MAPPING
