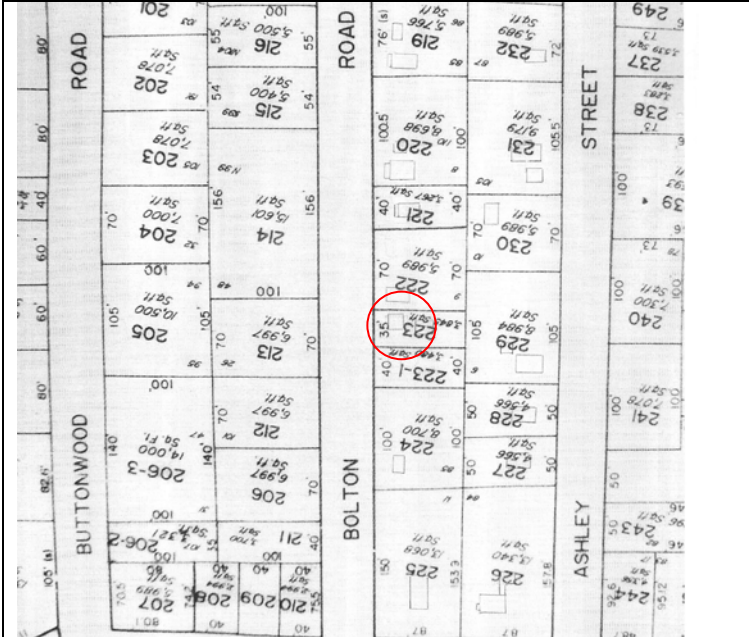

ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

Describe architectural features. Evaluate the characteristics of this building in terms of other buildings within the community.

The one-and-a-half story dwelling at 8 Bolton Road (DAR.701) faces east and is located approximately eight feet from the road. The lot is slightly sloped with a shed in the southwest corner and a chain link fence encompasses the yard to the north of the two by two bay dwelling. A gate on the north side of the building leads to the side yard and the stairs to the porch entrance. The rectangular building rests on a high painted brick foundation and terminates in a front gable roof sheathed in asphalt shingles. The hip roof front porch has been enclosed and rests on a concrete block foundation. The residence is clad in vinyl siding. An interior end chimney is located on the south slope of the gable roof. Fenestration includes 1/1 replacement sash windows, pairs of 1/1 sash windows and a large opening on the enclosed porch featuring a 1/1 sash windows flanked by narrow 1/1 sash windows.

HISTORICAL NARRATIVE
