ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

A 1-1/2 story Colonial Cape Cod of the type known as a $\frac{3}{4}$ Cape, with an off-center entrance flanked by one window to the left and two windows to the right. The windows are 12/12 wood sash behind aluminum storms. The window trim consists of simple flat casings and splayed lintels. A small 1-story, 1-bay wide wing to the right is set back from the main façade, has a 12/12 window and appears to be a 19th century addition. An addition to the left side is flush with the front and appears to be more recent. Behind that is another addition, part ell part wing, to which a covered porch is attached, all apparently 20th century additions. The building has a chimney centered on the ridge, wood clapboards on the front, wood shingles on the sides and rear.

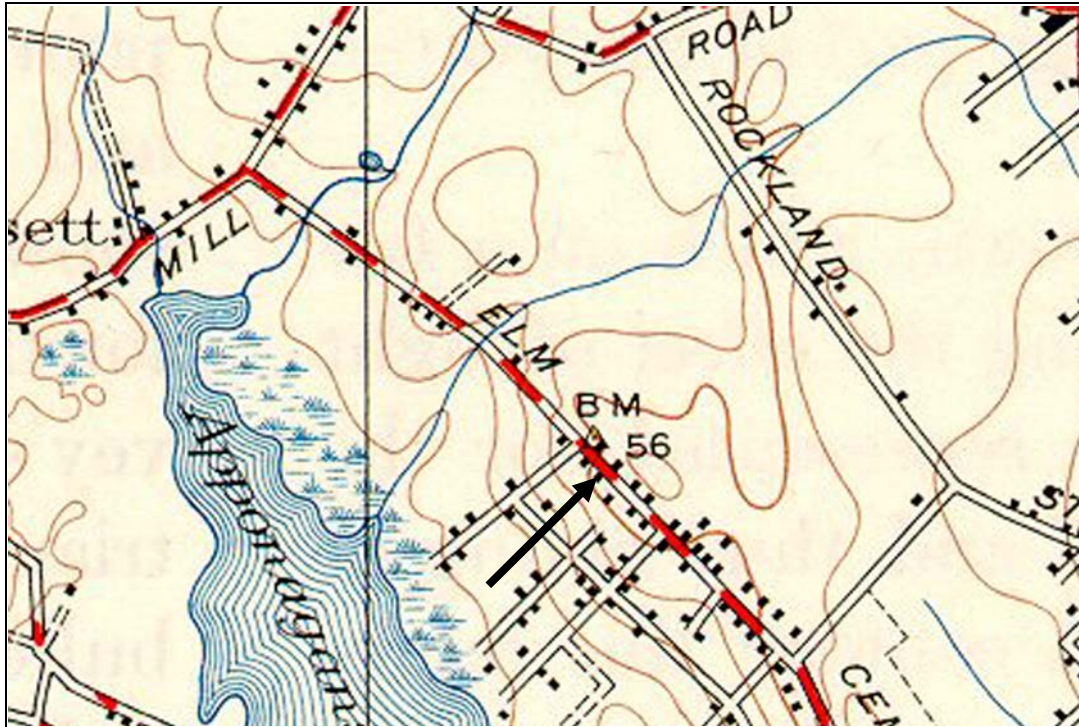

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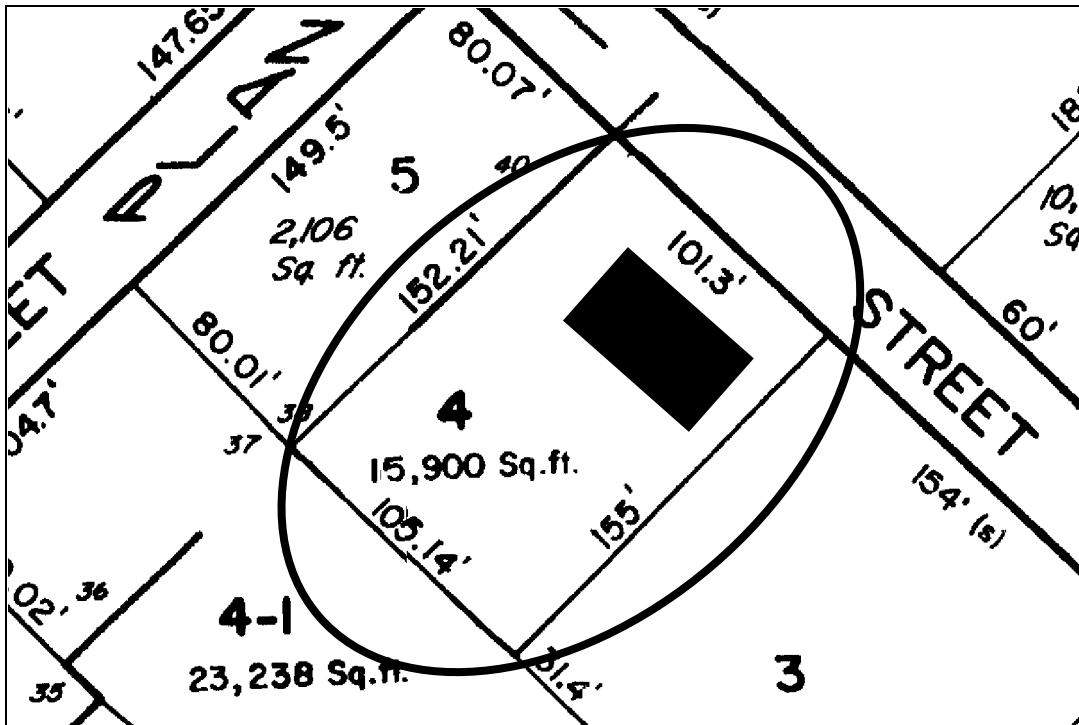
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LOCATION MAPPING
