## ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

A 1-1/2 story front-gable side-hall plan Greek Revival house on a brick foundation. The façade is 3 bays wide with the entrance on the left; there are two windows in the front gable. The solid paneled front door is framed by wide flat pilasters with crown moulding, narrow side lights a wide frieze and thin extended cornice typically seen in Dartmouth. The house is completely sided with cement-asbestos shingles. Windows on the front of the house are wood 2/2 sash; the rest of the windows are a mix of 2/2 and 6/6 wood sash. Windows are framed with flat trim; all other trim has been removed or buried under the replacement siding. There is a 1-story front-gable rear ell slightly offset to the left exposing one 6/6 window. There is a single-flue brick chimney off center towards the rear of the ell. A cross-gable addition to the rear ell on the right side, probably built early 20<sup>th</sup> century, extends over a screen porch.

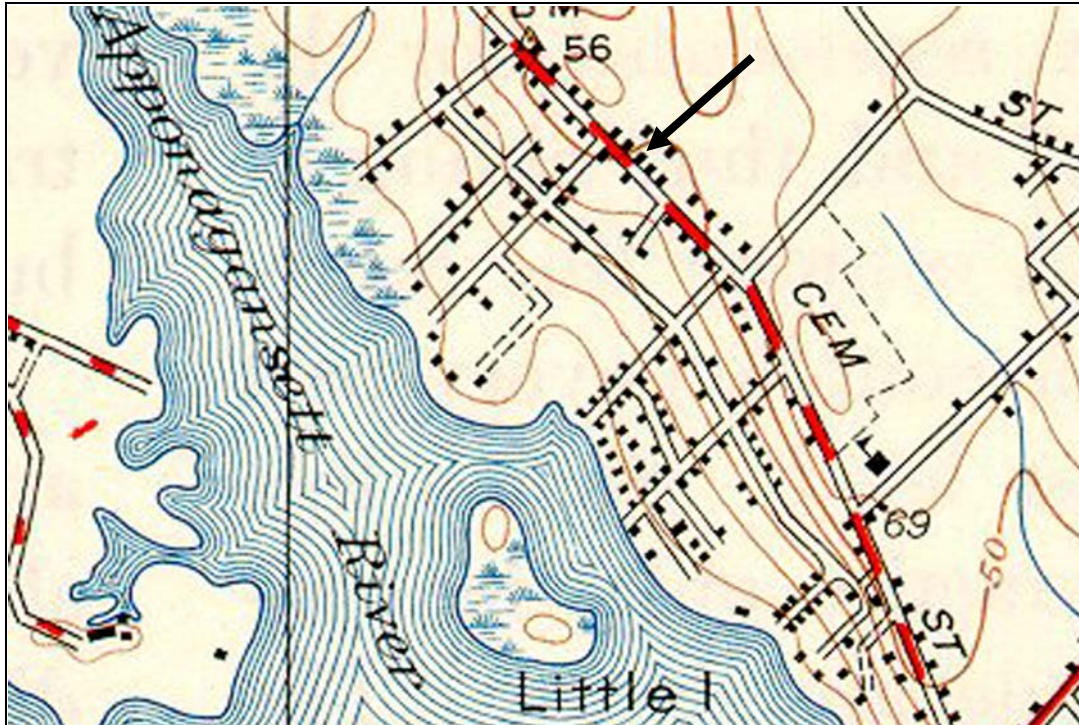

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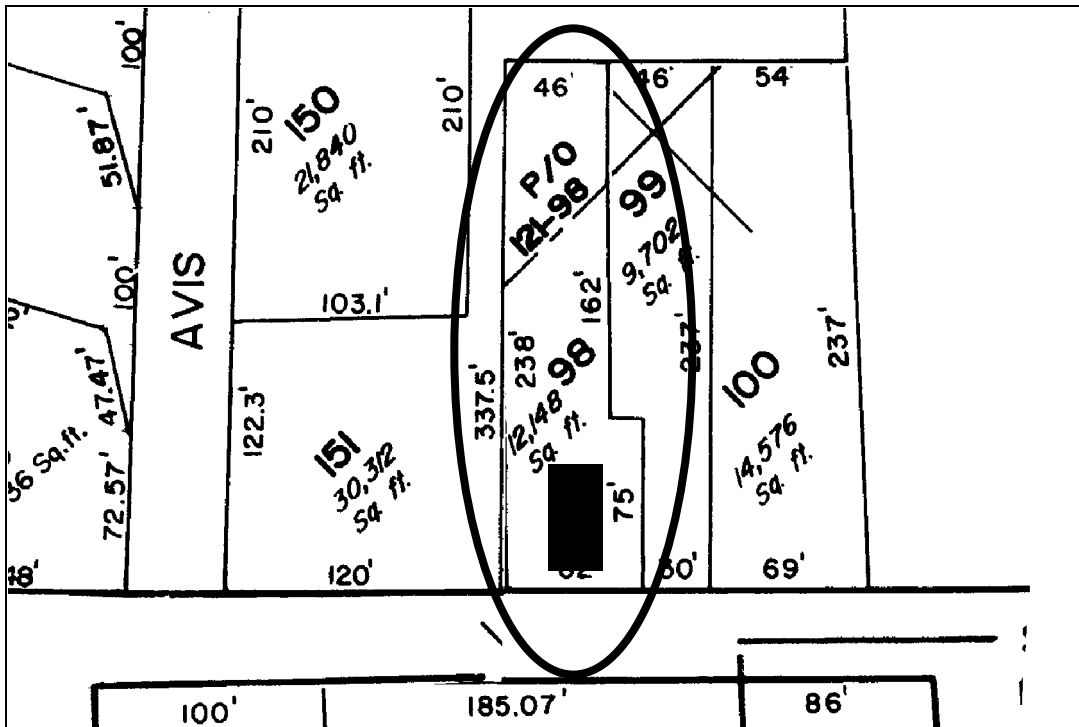
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**LOCATION MAPPING**
