ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

This structure is a 1 story half Cape Cod style house, 3 bays wide by 2 bays deep. The windows on the front façade and left side are 6/6 sash, and protected by aluminum storms. They are trimmed with flat casings and rectangular lintels. The first floor windows on the right side have been removed and replaced by a pair of smaller windows probably over a kitchen sink. An entrance portico over a small entrance porch has been recently added. The building has two chimneys; an off center interior one, and another external one on the left façade that is a modern addition. A large 1-story rear addition has all modern windows and is impossible to date. A new detached 1-bay garage was added in 2008.

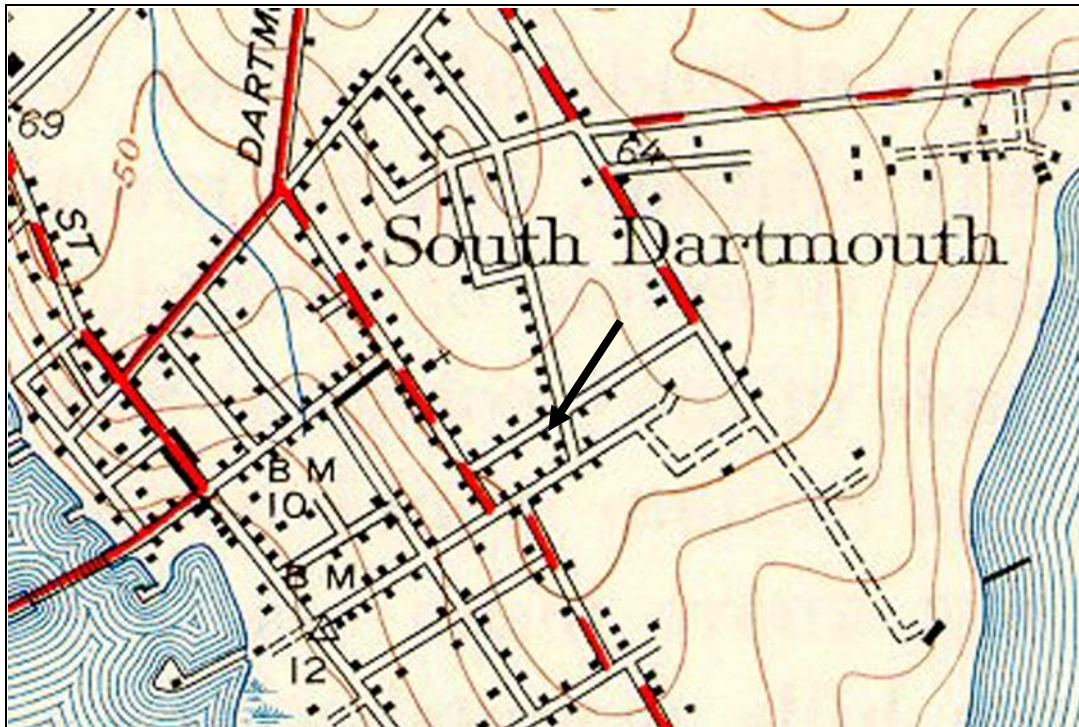

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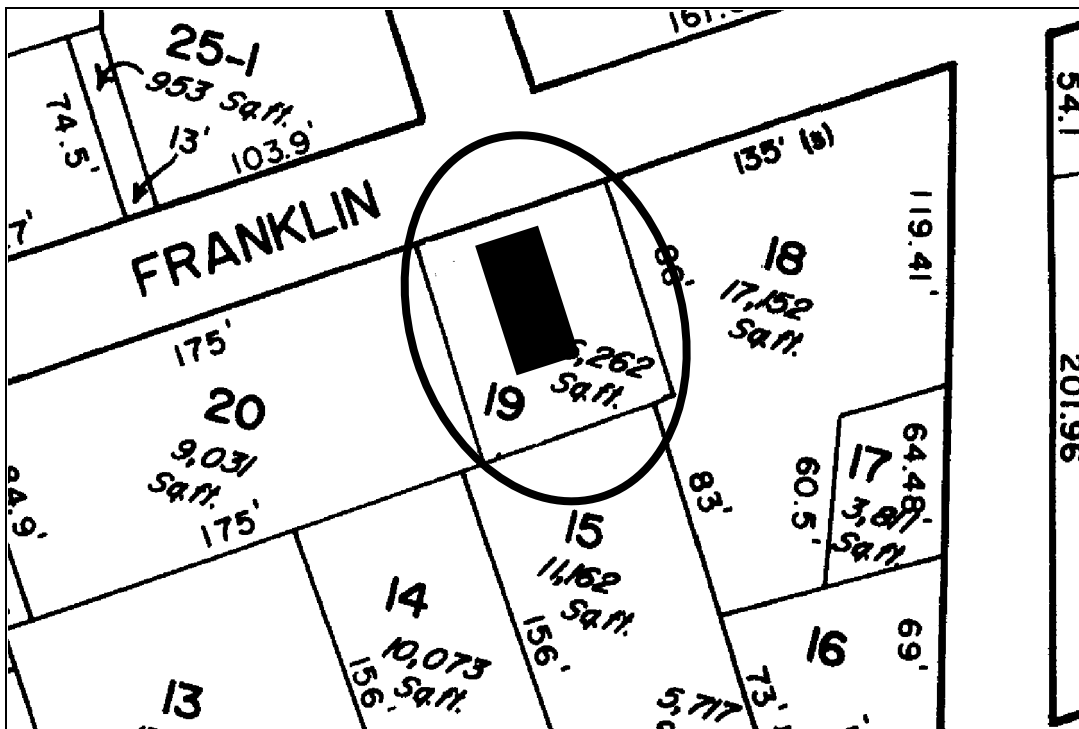
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LOCATION MAPPING
