## ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

This structure is a very handsome example of the Greek Revival mode in Dartmouth. The gable end is front facing and the front entrance is located at this façade on the right side. This doorway is framed by pilaster and sidelights. A front entrance porch is located here as well, and may be original to the structure. It is supported by paneled columns and the cornice of the porch roof is accented by dentils. The structure is 2 ½ stories in height and pilasters are at the corners. They are paneled. The cornice is extended and accented by brackets. Cornice ends in return. A square cupola is at roof, with panels, windows and an extended cornice with bracketing. Foundation and stairs are granite. [Note: Preceding description transcribed from 1983 survey form]

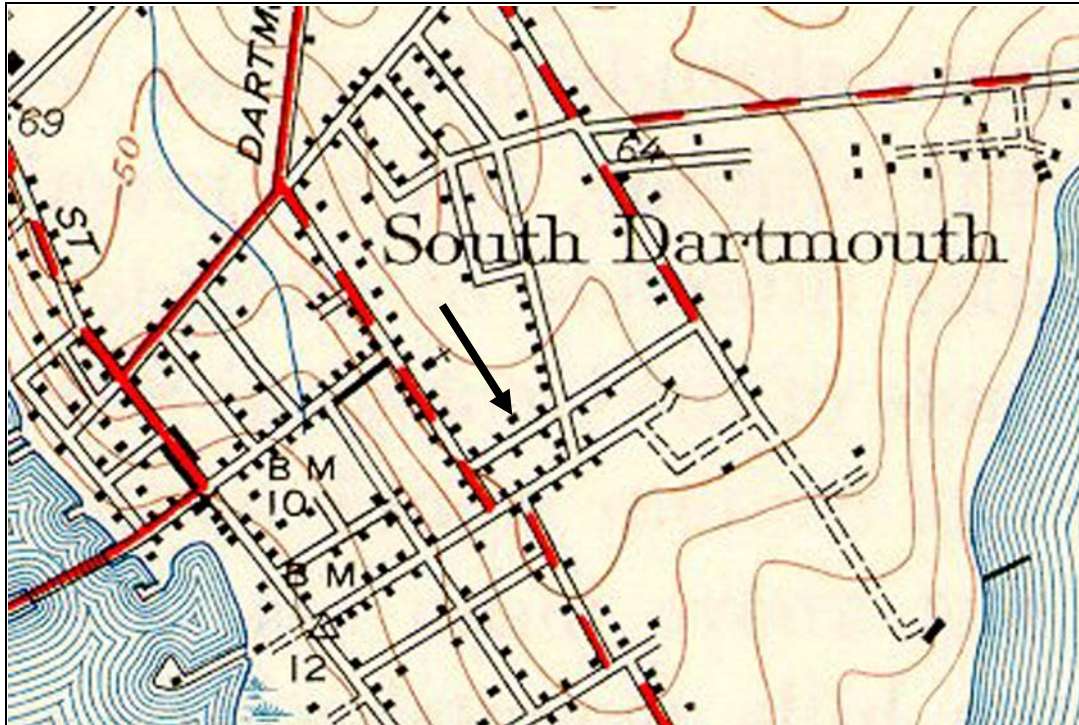

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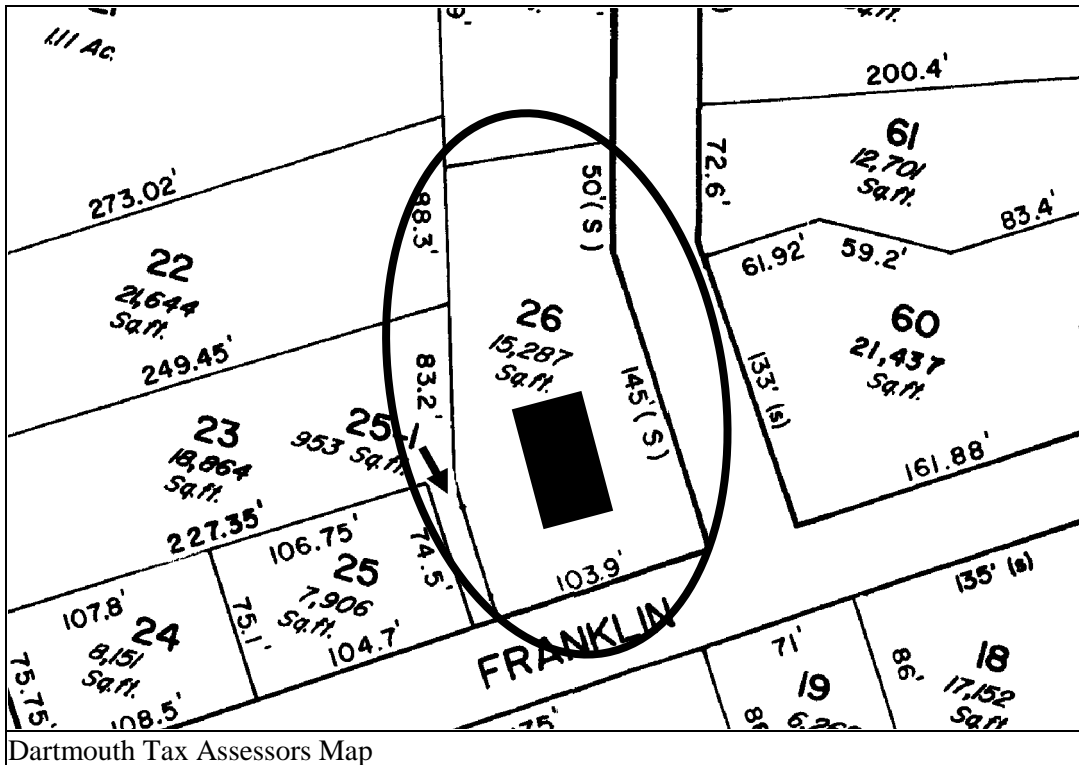
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**LOCATION MAPPING**
