ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

This house appears to date from the mid-to-late 19th century but lacks stylistic details. It is a 2-story side-gable house with a 1-story wing on a stone foundation. The form suggests that it was a typical vernacular Greek Revival/Italianate with wing. It has a later-added full-width front porch with a hip-roof supported on turned columns and a rusticated cement block foundation. A porch with a shed roof is attached to the side of the wing. Alterations include all new 1/1 vinyl windows, a modern bay window on the front of the wing and vinyl siding. There is a brick interior chimney at the back corner. A small secondary structure with low-pitch front gable roof extending over a narrow front porch was evidently one of several early or mid-20th century camp or roadside cottages that appear on the 1941 topo map below. Also note on the map that the road alignment has changed. The small wood-shingled garage may also be a converted cottage.

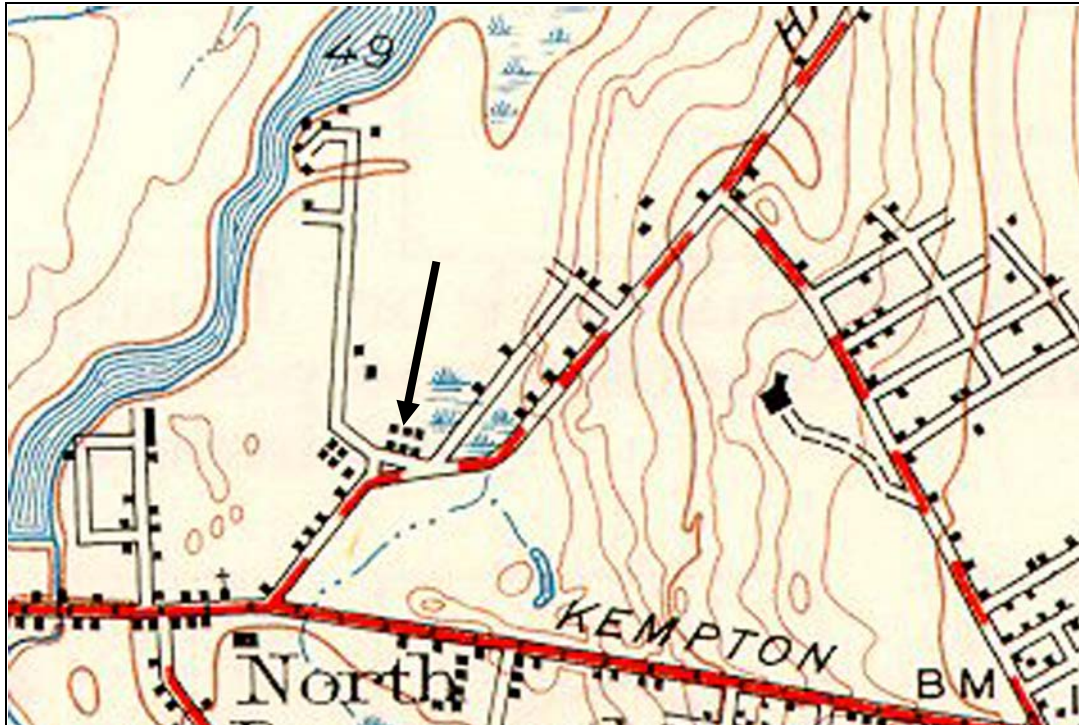

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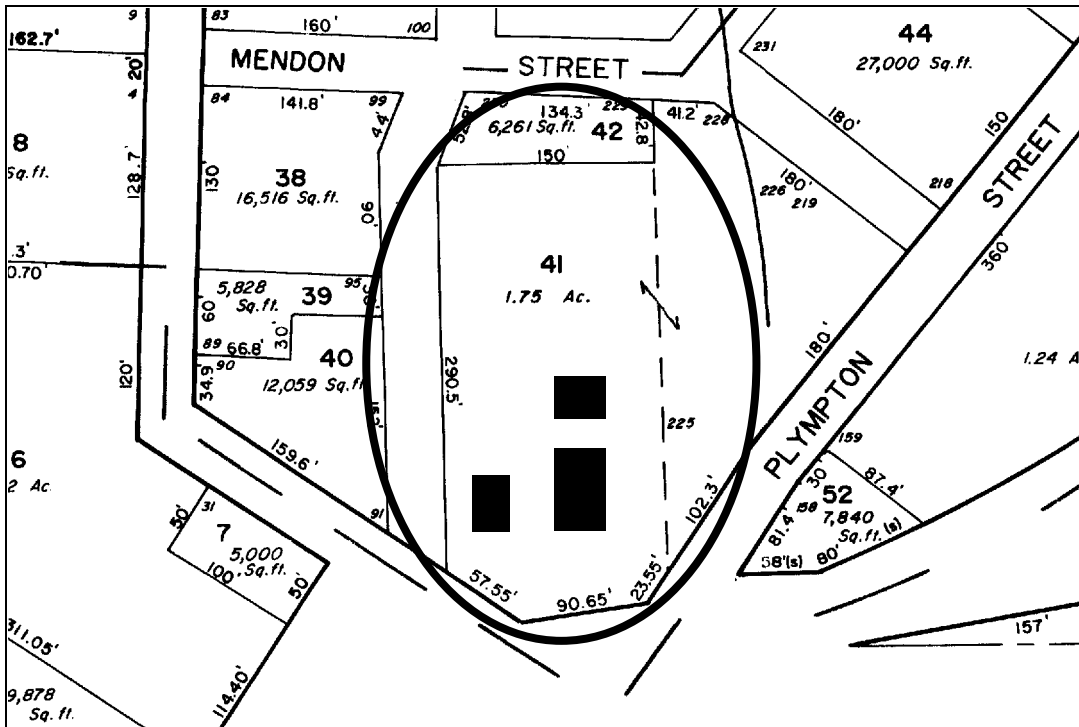
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LOCATION MAPPING
