ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

This is a 1-story rectangular plan front gable structure with an enclosed front porch and a small side entry addition on the left side. According to historic mapping a school stood on this property. The extent to which this house encloses or contains portions of the original school building is not evident from the exterior. All windows and doors are modern replacements that may or may not be located in original openings. There is a small interior brick chimney located on the left slope that might be 19th or 20th century. The structure has vinyl siding and all trim is replaced and/or encased in vinyl or aluminum. It rests on a parged stone foundation with the enclosed porch resting on a concrete foundation. The property does not retain its historic architectural integrity.

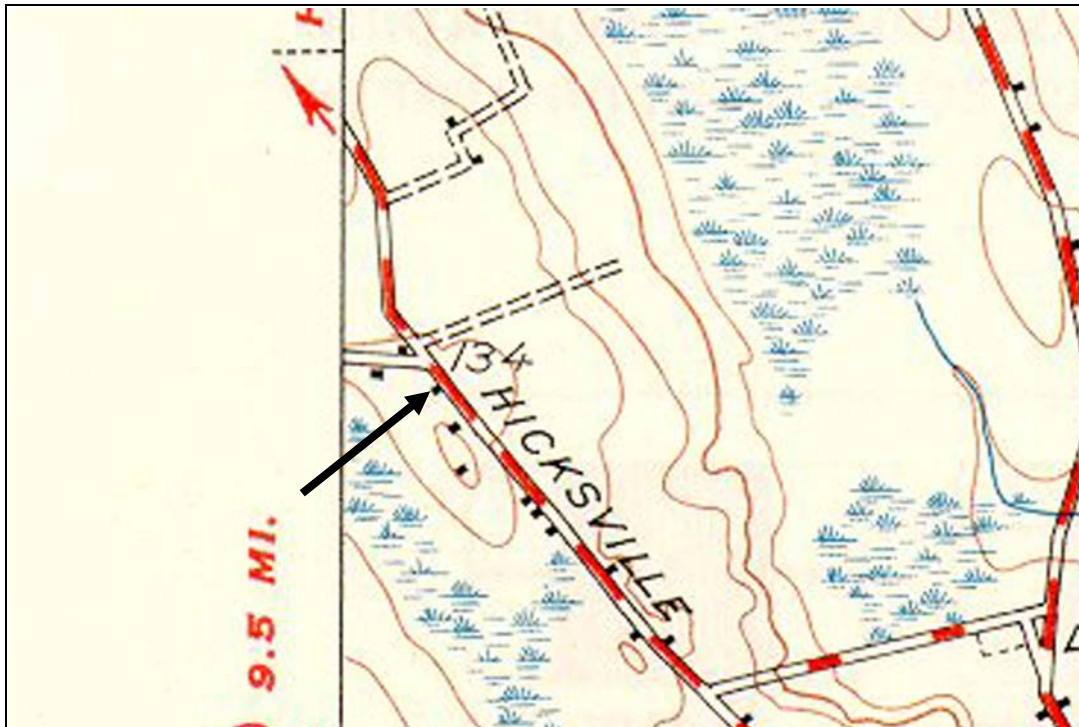

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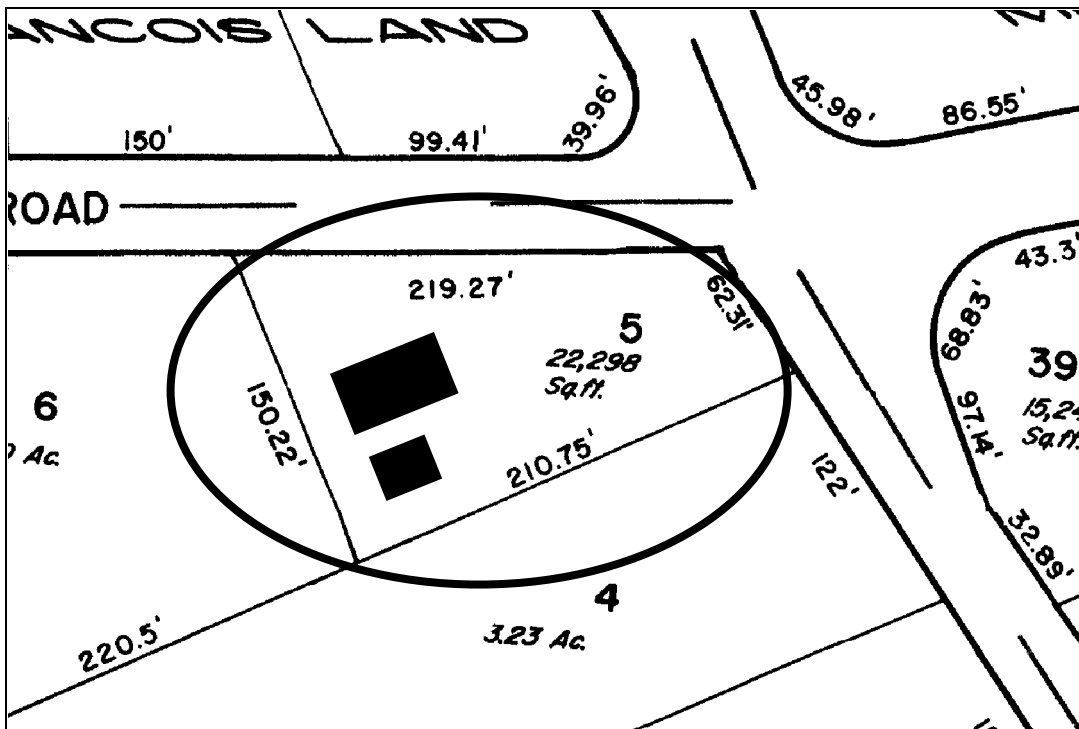
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LOCATION MAPPING
