Searching

1. Enter search term(s)
2. Limit your search (optional)
 - a. Use  to select a search type - default is Keyword
 - b. Use  to select which network(s) to search - default is All
3. Press 'Enter' or click  to view search results screen

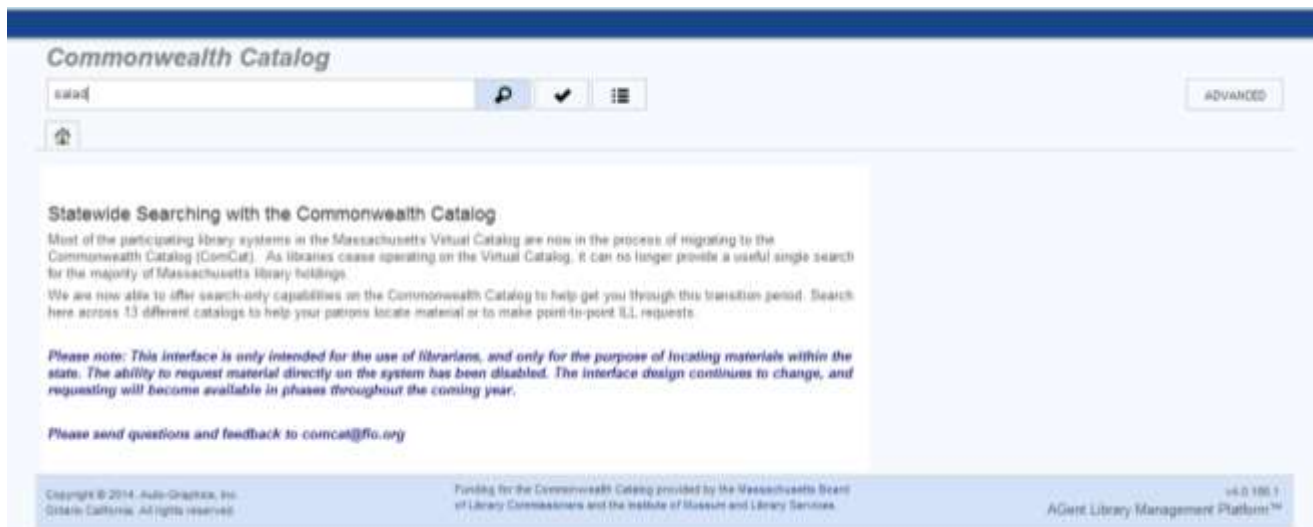


Figure 1 - Commonwealth Catalog Home Page

4. Search results are grouped by title. Titles with multiple formats or editions are grouped together (figure 2)









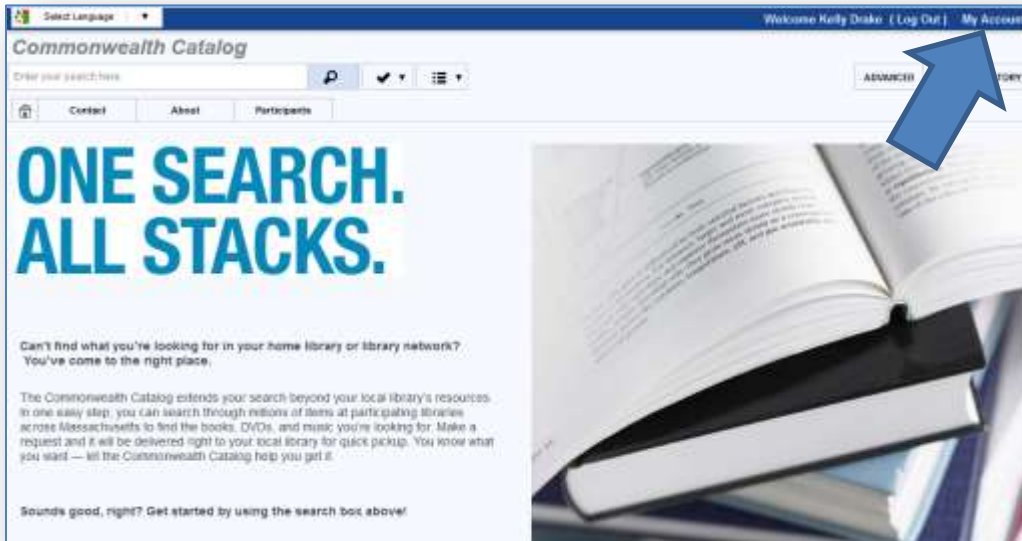
